DEPRESSION AND SUICIDE AMONG CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS

Depression and Suicide Among Children and Adolescents will help clinical professionals understand the unique presentation of depression within children and adolescents. The program will include discussions on the etiology, symptoms, appropriate diagnosis in this population, treatments, suicidal behaviors, and the impact on family and school environments. Mental Health Professionals and Educational Professionals such as School Counselors and Social Workers are often some of the first to interact with children and adolescents struggling with depression outside of the home. This program will address how to respond to these individuals, coordinate care with the treatment team and family. The program will also include a discussion on helping students effectively cope with the stressors of school.
